## About the Annual Juried Art Exhibit

For 46 years now, the Annual Juried Art Exhibit has featured the work of talented artists living within 250 miles of Chagrin Falls. The name of the show and the shape of the gallery have varied slightly over the last four decades, but it's always been a display of great art from around the region. This year, we feature artists from Lodi, Ohio to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Every time we present this exhibit, the center invites three new jurors to choose the exhibited art from hundreds of submissions. This year, Anna Arnold, Kristen Cliffl and Michael Gill selected 68 exemplary works from 57 artists. The show includes works of art in traditional mediums such as oil and watercolor as well as fiber, printmaking, ceramics and more. We are proud to announce over \$1000 in prizes will be awarded to 16 artists during the Opening Reception on Friday, November 3.
